

# Certificate 3 Guarantee



## Information for students

### Certificate 3 Guarantee

Eligible working age Queenslanders are entitled to State Government funding to help them complete a certificate level III qualification.

The Certificate 3 Guarantee will be paid to the training provider to reduce the cost of the certificate level III qualification to the student.

The amount provided by the Certificate 3 Guarantee will vary depending on the demand for skilled workers in a particular industry and each student's needs. Students should expect to contribute to the cost of their training through a student contribution fee.

The government pays a greater subsidy for high priority qualifications to help make them more affordable for students.

### Eligibility

The Certificate 3 Guarantee is for students who commence a certificate level III course on or after 1 July 2013, and who do not already hold or are undertaking a certificate level III or higher qualification.

Students can only access the Certificate 3 Guarantee subsidy once so it is important you take the time to carefully consider your training options, and compare different providers and their fees, before committing to a course of study.

- a refund policy outlining when you are entitled to a full or part refund of fees
- information about the support services available to assist you to complete the qualification.
